Since Laura came on board with us she's been desperate to go swimming as she is doing a charity swim called "Swim 22" to raise money for diabetes.

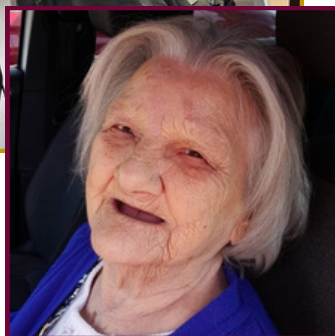
